Plettenberg Bay is a celebrated world-class beach destination with 35 km of picturesque coastline, the most unique natural asset for the town. In addition to the 6 Blue Flag status beaches, there are coastal areas classified as Important Bird and Biodiversity Areas (IBA) by Birdlife South Africa. Maintaining Plett as one of the Garden Route's premier tourism destinations and keeping our largest economic contributor to the town protected is most important.



NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED on Blue Flag status beaches and several other beaches in Plett – **these beaches are all sign-posted NO DOGS ALLOWED**



DOGS MUST BE LEASHED at all times on most beaches in Plett to respect our non-dog walking visitors – these beaches are all sign-posted DOGS ON LEASH



DOG WALKING BEACH RULES IN PLETT

DOG WALKERS - **read signs** at all public beach entrances, transition zones and on the beaches
DOG WALKERS - **leash your dog where designated**

DOG WALKERS - **keep dogs off all Blue Flag beaches** and other beaches that are sign-posted NO DOGS ALLOWED

DOG WALKERS - **be responsible for removing any dog waste immediately** from all public areas



MORE DOG BEACH RULES IN PLETT

DOGS **listen to your walkers** - you can't heed the call of every canine friend or foe

DOGS **do not interfere with other beach visitors** - even those with super yummy treats

DOGS **no wildlife may be chased or harmed**, no matter how tempting



IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER

Visitors unaccompanied by dogs enjoys right of way

All beach rules must be complied with

DOGS FREE OF LEAD is only open on designated beaches in Plett – these select beaches are all sign-posted
